

Program Overview


Glove Production can be linked into three categories of production:

String Knits
Cut and Sew
Rubber Gloves

- Product Line: Combat Gloves, Wet Weather Gear, MC Martial Arts Training Kits, Tapes, Webbings, Fasteners, Needles and Threads
- Special Program Support:
 - Nuclear Program Support Critical support
 - -Wildland Firefighting Three Gloves and Protective Chaps
- # of Items: Approximately 381 active PGCs
- Critical Acquisitions: Otto Fuel Glove (O2N), Electrical Gloves (O2N) (various voltages), White Simplex (Old Guard/Ceremonial), Multiple Items for Afghan Security Forces, Rubber Industrial Gloves
- Command Interest: Nuclear Program Support
 Otto Fuel critical safety/foreign source of supply

Cold Weather Glove System




Where We Are:

- US Army current cold weather hand wear consists of 7 items ranging from liner and anti-contact gloves to Extreme Cold Weather (ECW) mittens
- Some components of the system are no longer procurable. The Trigger Finger (TF)
 Mitten Liner for example is no longer domestically produced. The TF liner was shared
 between the TF mitten and the ECW mitten
- Results from CTAPS-H study demonstrated areas where Soldiers feel improvements can be made
 - · ECW mitten well regarded
 - Intermediate Cold Wet Glove can be improved
 - Dexterity study, user eval show value in TF mitten
 - ECW mitten identified as versatile



Where We Want To Go:

- Modular cold weather hand wear solution that balances protection from environmental and man made threats found in extreme cold weather environments
 - Packable/light weight
 - Moisture management
 - Durable
 - Capacitive
 - FR/NMND
- Investigate Novel materials and design solutions





Army Combat Glove-Capacitive, Gauntlet



Where We Are:

- The Army has transitioned the Army Combat Glove (ACG) from RFI to Defense Logistics Support – Troop Support (DLA-TS)
- The ACG-C is a capacitive variant of the ACG that allows the wearer to interact with touch screen devices while gloved
- Joint interest from USAF





Where We Want To Go:

- Gauntleted version of the standard ACG-C to support Aviators and Combat Vehicle Crewmen
 - Limited user evaluation with mounted and aviation units for FY18
 - Evaluation of design features aimed at improved digital device interface and durability
 - Safe-to Fly

 - Type II Touch Screen enabled
 - Classes
 - Class 1 Sage green/Gray Leather (type I only)
 - Class 2 Desert Tan cloth/Tan leather (type II only)
 - Class 3 Black Deleted
 - Class 4- Coyote cloth/Coyote Leather (type II only)
 - Class 5- Sage cloth/Sage leather (type II only)
- Leather, Sheepskin, Chrome Tanned, Conductive (Touchscreen) is FQ/PD 4672-16-01

- In the meantime AF Safe To Fly List allows Aviators to purchase directly from suppliers
