Army Maternity Uniform (AMU)



Where We Were:

- Army Maternity Uniform (AMU)
 - Complaints from female soldiers:
 - Fit is not proportioned correctly
 - Ill-fitting during any stage of pregnancy
 - Last update was 1979

Where We Are Going:

- Adopted the USAF design, with cosmetic changes
 - Collar to resemble current Army Combat Uniform (ACU)
 - Hook and loop for nametapes and unit patches
 - Operational Camouflage Pattern
- Fabric remains the same current ACU
- Improved nylon tricot belly panel
- Finalizing technical data and supply request to transition to Defense Logistics Agency-Troop Support (DLA-TS) for procurement FY18
