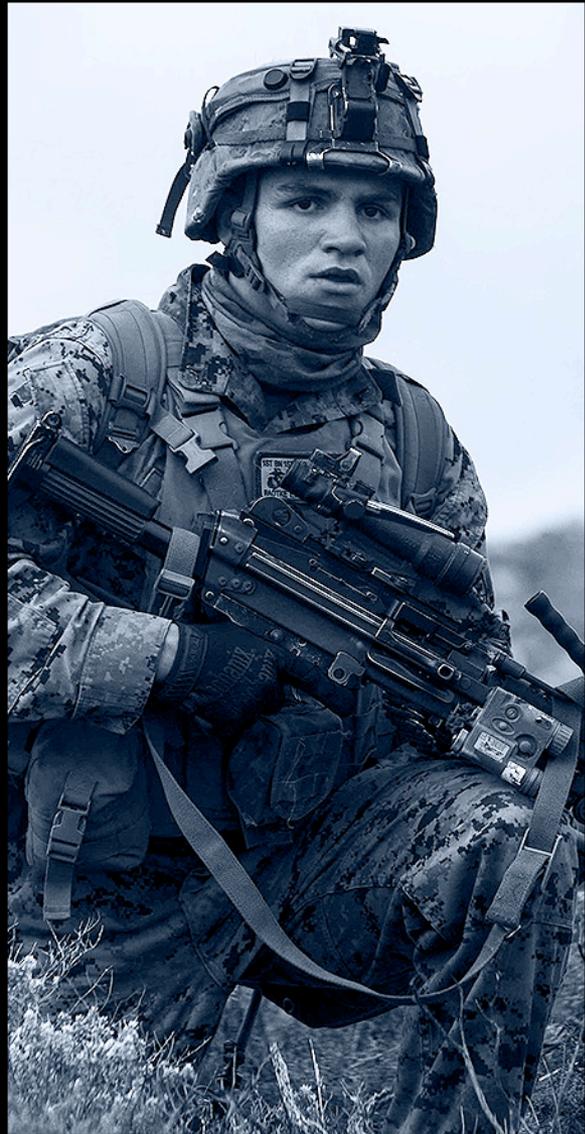



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Aviation Aircrew Combat Uniform (A2CU)



Where We Are:

- Aviation Aircrew Combat Uniform (A2CU)
 - Requirements generated in 1977 / 1985
 - Produced only in unisex version
 - Female version developed 2013
 - Not implemented due to low demand
 - USAF adopted the unisex version of the uniform for flight crews



Where We Are Going:

- Increased number of female service members on aircrews
 - USAF taking lead in developing female patterns for A2CU
 - Army sharing all data from 2013 development
 - Testing scheduled to begin 3FY20 by both Services
 - Expecting production late 2021
 - Navy invited to participate



Improved Combat Vehicle Crewman Coverall (iCVC)



Where We Are:

- Improved Combat Vehicle Crewman Coverall (iCVC)
 - Requirements generated in 1979
 - Low demand/hot/impeded mobility
 - Soldiers prefer FR ACU



Where We Are Going:

- User community developing requirement
 - Determining capabilities needed
 - Developing updated capabilities document
- Will use performance based requirements
- Open to one piece or two piece garments

AFLCMC... Providing the Warfighter's Edge

Background:

- Fit evaluation of unisex A2CU validated need for female sizes for comfort and safety
- Design will mirror unisex design with modifications required for smaller sizes

What We've Done:

- Conducted Fit event at Norfolk
- Started pattern making and prototype fabrication

Plan Forward:

- Acquire Tri-Service MOU approval
- Sep 2021: Final Pattern Hand-off to Army
- Dec 2021: Army adds A2CU-F design to its existing A2CU DLA contract






A2CU-Female Fit Proposed Schedule
