



Cloth, Fusible	Front fusible material used in dress uniform coats		
High-tenacity polyester fiber 1300d+	Material used in various items including parachute suspension lines, aircraft seats, and shelters;		
Latex Polyester Fabric and Resin Polyester Fabric	Material used in Webbing Straps to secure loads for transport and storage		
Fire Hose (garden hose)	One specific NSN (National Stock Number)		
Fire Hoses	Four specific NSNs		
Impermeable Aprons	Supporting Ebola response		
Padding and Haircloth Chest Piece	Used on Army Men's and Women's Dress Coats		
Nitrile Rubber Gloves	Protective gloves used by Navy to protect against certain fuels		
Snap Fastener	Used on Marine Corps Men's Dress Coats		
Acrylic Staple Fiber	Used in Acrylic Fiber Sandbags		
Medical Surgical Prime Vendor items	Class DNAD covering FSCs 6510, 6515, 6520, 6530, 6532, 6540, 6545, 6640, 7210, 8335 (Bandages, gauze, sponges, cotton pellets, medical clothing, surgical instruments, etc.)		
Rayon Yarn	Used in dress clothing, individual equipment, insignia, flags, streamers, guidons		
Fire-resistant material	Used in items requiring flash protection, tents, pilot clothing

Simplex Cotton	Used in Dress Gloves		
Polyester/Wool fabric	Used in Dress Clothing		
Otto Fuel Protective Fabric	For apparel to protect personnel working around torpedo and rocket fuel


