Size Standardization (SS)

BACKGROUND:

- Male and female legacy uniforms were developed in late 80's with no standardized or systematic approach in pattern development

OBJECTIVE:

- Identify today's sizing and body types
 - FY14-15 USN Anthropometric Correlation Study
- Increase ROIs for Sailor and NEXCOM with the development and utilization of Size Standardization (SS) tools

PROPOSALS FOR FUTURE EFFORTS:

5 YEAR PLAN

- Male/Female Uniforms
 - Dress (E7 and above)
 - Service (E6 and below, E7 and above)

ALTERNATIVE / INCLUSIVE SIZING

- Male Big and Tall
- Female Plus
- Gender Neutral
- Transgender
- Special Orders

SS MILESTONES:

Short Term:

FY18: Female "New Fit"

Long Term:

FY19: Female SS, regular stature

FY20-22: Female SS, all statures

FY21: Male SS, regular stature (data only)

FY22: Fit & wear evaluation, Service Uniforms

FY22 FIELD TEST:

- Fit evaluation and wear test of Female Service Uniforms
 - Validate identified female sizes and shapes for all statures
 - Evaluate USN uniform patterns developed utilizing SS tools
 - Test: JUN-JUL 2022 Tidewater area
