It's Been A Long Time Since 1962

- For the first time since 1962 the Defense Department has revised the DD 1222 REQUEST FOR AND RESULTS OF TESTS
- While DLA uses this form, we are not the only defense agency that uses it, hence some modifications on the form are not directed at the C&T supply chain
- C&T sent out a notice that the older form DD 1222 would not be accepted for submitted testing past October 15, 2021
- If the PTC-A receives an older DD 1222, or receives a DD 1222 that is incorrectly filled out, modified from the format, or is missing information important to the testing being performed someone from the PTC-A will reach out to you



It's A New Day!

- The email will come from the pactlab@dla email box with a request for a corrected DD 1222
- While we wait for a response, the work will not be logged into our system, and will not be tested or evaluated.
- After 48 hours we will attempt to contact you again
- If we still have not heard back in 48 hours, we will attempt one final request, and turn the matter over to the contracting officer.
- Please do not contact the shade team if they are not who contacted you.
- Prime's please communicate all necessary information to subcontractors to avoid delays in testing.

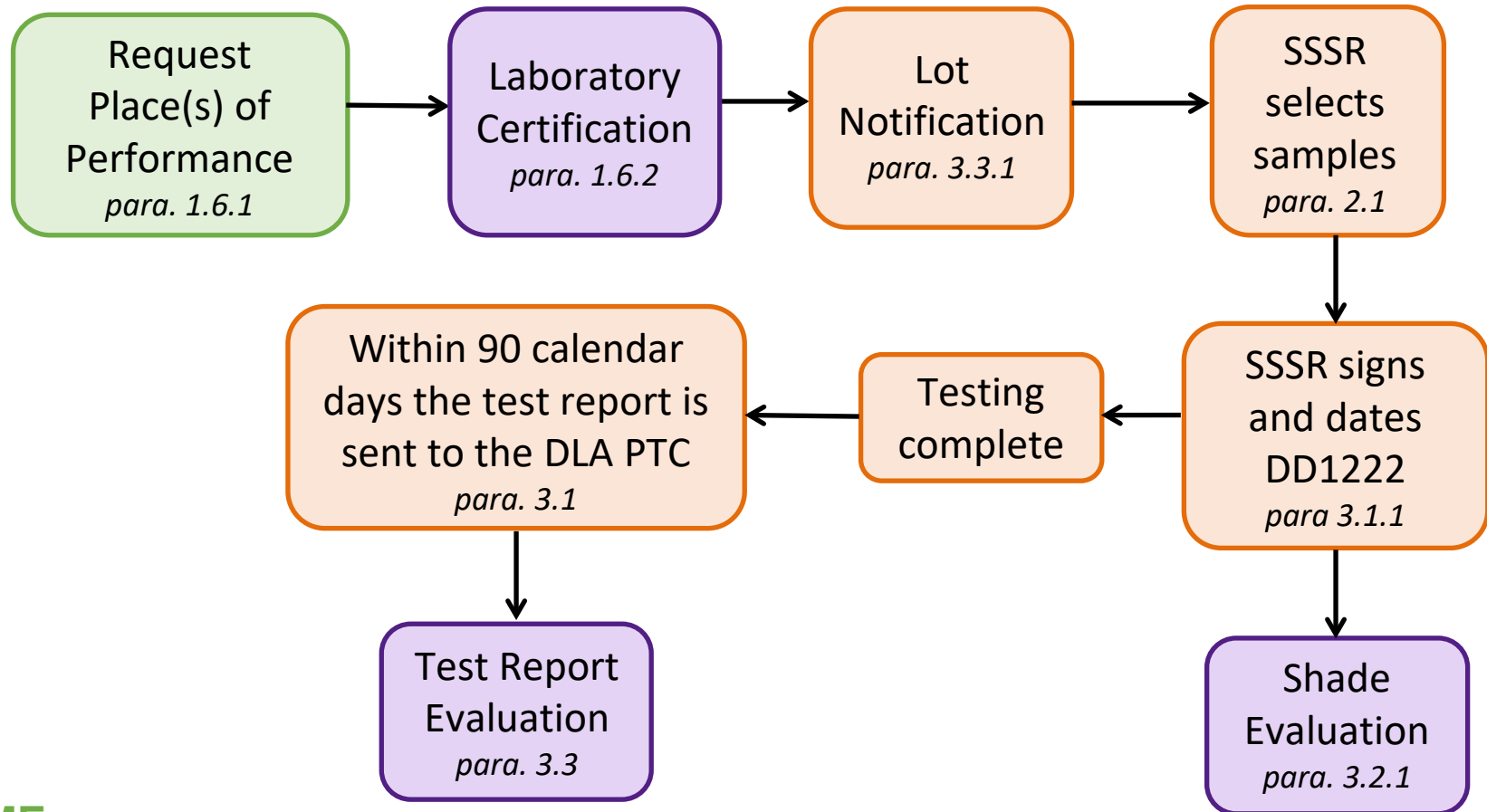


The Right Way

- In the DLA Troop Support Clothing & Textiles Additional Quality Assurance Requirements Page 37-40 are specific instructions on how the form should be filled out
- If you are submitting for lot notification, shade evaluation, and source sampling please make sure the contractor, contract number, specification and lot number match on each request that comes to the PTC-Analytical
- The PTC needs help with data integrity
- DLA should treat all contractors and subcontractors fairly
- Prepare for the Source Sampling Portal
- Standardization is key
- Item identification – brand names/style numbers do not link to contractual information

What Not to Do

No Modification – Do not shrink or grow any boxes

Box 7 should only say Correlation testing when submitting side by side samples.

Test reports should be submitted as Source Sampling

In box 9, no multiple choice! For each item list by the item submitted (cloth, leather, end item) with a material description

Specification in box 12 should be the same on the DD 1222 and the test report

No brand names to describe the item

What To Do

Test reports should be submitted as shade evaluation

Is the shade number in box 22?

Is the standard roll number in box 22?

Is everyone who is supposed to get a copy of the report added in box 23?

Is there a tally sheet attached with roll numbers that match the samples submitted?

Does the item/spec/contract/lot number match the source report.

Don't forget you have to send the source report!
