


# Dress Clothing – Material Obligations FY2021-FY2023








# Dress Clothing – Material Obligations FY2023 Planned vs. Actual









- Supplier Performance Risk System (SPRS):
   Your SPRS Delivery Score is reviewed for award decisions. Vendors should review their Negative Delivery Records for accuracy. If a Due Date is incorrect, if a Ship/Rec Date is missing or wrong, or if late shipment was due to government delay contact timothy.atwell@dla.mil for assistance. Tim Atwell is always available to help with any questions, concerns or SPRS website access and navigation.
- Request delivery extensions before lateness occurs





## **Key Points**

- Any Vendor Can Request Courtesy Evaluations
- Delivery Date Definitions
  - Delivery date is when the item arrives at the destination.
- Communicate Bad Information ASAP
  - Helps us plan and inform the customer upfront if there is a delay.
- Never make a technical change unless you have a signed modification.
- Tiered Pricing
- New Address to send PDMs and Samples. Send on time.
- DIBBS is the official website to submit bids.






- Develop a Women's version of the Men's Mess Dress pant as an additional option to the Skirt



MARINE CORPS UNIFORM ITEMS AND ACCESSORIES

JAPBI 16 Nov 2023

- Established to ensure Marine Corps uniform items and accessories manufactured for sale through the Marine Corps Exchange (MCX) and designated Retail Clothing Outlets meet USMC requirements and standards
- TM 10120-15/2 (Certification Manual) provides guidance.
- The mandate for optional clothing and uniform accessory quality assurance is provided in the current edition of the Marine Corps Order (MCO) P10120.28, Individual Clothing Regulations.
- Marine Corps uniform items and accessories listed in the United States Marine Corps Regulation (MCO P1020.34H)
- Covered Items:
  - All Marine Corps Officer items that do not have a national stock number (NSN) and meet or exceed base specification requirements
  - Enlisted items that exceed base specification requirements and are not under DLA contract

Currently 262 items certified from 46 certified vendors







# MARINE CORPS SYSTEMS COMMAND Equipping our MARINES


#### **Certification Program Submission**

- Vendors with products that meet the specified criteria and wish to participate in the Certification Program must submit samples to PM Infantry Weapons Clothing & Equipment (IW/C&E) for inspection and approval.
- Documentation required for the submittal process includes a completed Manufacturer's Application Certification (MAC) form, a Finished Measurement Confirmation form, and a Test Requirements Results form.
- Items that receive approval are issued a certification number unique to the item, manufacturer, subcontractor (if applicable), and geographic manufacturing location.
- Each manufacturing site must have its own approved certification number for each item being manufactured at its location.
- New certification numbers are required for any product change, change in subcontractor, or change in manufacturing location.
- Items manufactured for the USMC Certification Program must conform to specifications and requirements throughout the life of the certification.



#### **Certification Program Inspection**


- Items are inspected to meet specifications and requirements.
  - Validate and verify an item meets requirements in terms of an item's final measurements, design, construction, and performance
  - Visual inspection, physical inspection, and testing will verify and validate product conformance
- Certifications are valid for three to five years depending on product category.
- Marine Corps designated personnel apply quality assurance processes to all certified items protecting the manufacturer and the Marine Corps.
- Marine Corps designated personnel conduct quality audits.
- Includes on-site plant inspections, inspection of items at exchange locations and retail outlets, solicitation of additional material or documentation for inspection and testing. The frequency and method chosen for the quality assessment is at the discretion of PM IW.







- Letter of approval signed by Product Manager (PdM)
- Certifications are valid for three to five years, depending on product category
- Certification numbers are included on garment labels to indicate an item is authorized
- Certification numbers are unique to each manufacturer and associated subcontractor manufacturing site
- Manufacturing facilities are subject to inspection and certification can be revoked for non-compliance
- A list of certified items, their assigned certification approval numbers, expiration dates and vendor names is included on the Marine Corps Certified Sources List.
- The Marine Corps Certified Sources List is published by PM IW and is used by retail outlets as a purchasing reference.


