

TIER CONTRACT PRICING

Tier Contract Pricing

The tier contract pricing approach embraces the concept of a multi-year ordering period. A Guaranteed Minimum Quantity (Generally 25% of AEQ) applies to the first tier/year only. A single Contract Maximum Quantity (Generally 125% of AEQs) for the life of the contract applies. A Maximum Monthly Quantity and Quarterly Delivery Orders also apply.





ECONOMIC PRICE ADJUSTMENT

Economic Price Adjustment

In general, C&T solicitations do not include an Economic Price Adjustment (EPA) Clause. Prior to solicitation issuance/opening, a market research survey is posted on https://sam.gov which provides the opportunity for any company interested in supplying an end item to state if they would like an EPA clause included in the solicitation. If so, the company is required to provide the index/indices to be considered for the EPA clause and the basic material(s) percentage of end item cost that the PPI will apply to. Please understand that an upward ceiling and downward floor of no more than 10% of the applicable base unit price shall apply.





PRODUCT DEMONSTRATION MODELS

Product Demonstration Models

Product Demonstration Models (PDMs) are required to be submitted through traceable means via the U.S. Postal Service or a Commercial Carrier (Example: FedEx, Airborne, UPS, DHL, Emery). In-person delivery of PDMs by offerors is NOT authorized. The Tracking Number shall be provided as part of the DIBBS electronic upload proposal submission.

PRODUCT DEMONSTRATION MODELS (Cont'd)

PDMs are to be delivered between 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. E.S.T., Monday through Friday, except for legal federal holidays. Packages must be plainly marked ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE CARRIER'S PACKAGE with the solicitation number, date, and time set forth for receipt of offers. Ultimately, it is the offeror's responsibility to ensure that its PDMs are RECEIVED at the correct location at the correct time. Failure to do so may result in the offeror's proposal being deemed untimely and not considered further for the award.

Effective 01 October 2021, all carriers/individuals attempting to deliver any packages/proposals/PDMs/First Articles/etc. to DLA Troop Support shall have present credentials that meet Real ID requirements in order to gain access to make a delivery. NO EXCEPTIONS SHALL BE MADE.





PROCUREMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CENTERS

Procurement Technical Assistance Centers

Procurement Technical Assistance Centers (PTACS) provide local, in-person counseling and training services for small business owners that want to sell products/services to federal, state, and/or local governments. They are designed to provide technical assistance to include the following:

 Help facilitate communication among businesses, Small Business programs, and Government contracting representatives.





PROCUREMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CENTERS (Cont'd)

- Provide information and education on Federal and other Government acquisition regulations, procedures, procurement terminology, and best practices.
- Help businesses identify contract/bid opportunities, procurement history, suppliers, subcontractors, and any other information needed to successfully compete for a contract
- Offer seminars, classes, individual counseling, and agency specific training on security requirements, bid software, etc.

Program Description

- Currently there is no touchscreen compatible CWCG in the Marine Corps System for issue.
- Following initial USMC LUEs, Army request received in Feb 2023 to make this a joint effort due to the same capability gap identified by both USMC & Army.
- Effort is also being tracked by Air Force.

Current Status

- Recent Army interest in making this a joint effort resulted in USMC schedule delay moving forward with finalized requirements / Technical Data Package.
- Army requires no melt/drip (NMND) against skin
 currently building spec requirements. Updated fabric consists of:
 - Nylon / Spandex face,
 - o Laminated to modacrylic/lyocell/spandex (NMND),
 - o With film providing high water / wind resistance.
- Specification drafted; will be finalized following Army user evaluation.
- o Army FY24 LUE planned (Alaska).

Highlights for Industry

- Award will be for a 5 year IDIQ contract
- Solicitation for Sealed Bids with an open period of 60 days

- o First delivery due 180 days after award
- Monthly deliveries will ramp up to 4,000 complete sets per month by 9th month after award
