## 1) CONTRACT AWARD

a. - c. FAR 52.216-2 Economic Price Adjustment Standard Supplies (Jan 1997), which was completed by Easy Street and returned to DLA Troop Support on April 25, 2019 is hereby incorporated into the contract.
- d. Easy Street's confirmation of "NET 30" Discount terms are acceptable and are incorporated into this contract.
- e. 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
