Colonel Robert L. Ward II United States Army, (RET)

is inducted into the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia Hall of Fame this sixteenth day of October 2003 for his continuous outstanding mission support from 1992 through 1997. Robert Ward has distinguished himself as a visionary officer and a world class logistician who helped develop DSCP as a 21st century leader to support the men and women of our Armed Forces. While serving as the Director of the Clothing and Textile Factory and later Director of the Clothing and Textiles Directorate, he was recognized as a "superstar who has improved the wholesale system for years to come." His most significant and enduring contribution was his management and development of people, especially during the difficult time of the factory closure.
