Mr. Lampe was an innovative developer of numerous automated information and operations systems which were utilized throughout DISC and exported to other centers within DLA. Some of the major system development efforts which he conceived, developed and implemented include the Selective Management Category Code (SMCC), Requisition Optimization, Prioritization, Contract Expedite Status System (CESS), Pre-Recommended Buy Acquisition Planning (PREBAP), Recommended Buy Sequencing System (RBSS) and the Gradient Inventory Model (GIM).
