is inducted into the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia Hall of Fame this sixteenth day of October 2003 for his extraordinary leadership and support as DSCP's second Commander from 1998 to 2000. Under General Mongeon's leadership, DSCP was the catalyst for applying the best commercial practices to the full spectrum of military operations while saving billions of dollars in DoD resources and assets. He took two supply centers in the middle of a DoD BRAC imposed reduction and led it into a \$5 billion operation. He totally reinvented and focused on the needs of the joint warfighter. The success of his innovative efforts was visibly demonstrated in Kosovo operations where DSCP provided over \$120 million in critical food, clothing, medical and basecamp supplies .
