COLONEL JOHN A. CAPUTA U.S. MARINE CORPS (RET)

Is inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this eleventh day of July 1996 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Director of DPSC's Clothing & Textile Directorate – and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC – from 1984 to 1989. Colonel Caputa established the first dedicated source development organization in the Clothing & Textile Directorate. His effective efforts generated new sources for many critical uniform items. He also presided over a top-to-bottom restructuring of C&T's business practices which included implementing innovative contracting techniques to ensure contract awards to most capable, rather than low-cost, producers.
