COLONEL NICHOLAS CRADDOCK U.S. ARMY

Is posthumously inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this third day of June 3rd 1997 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Chief of DPSC's Subsistence Supply Operations Division – and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC – from 1978 to 1983. Colonel Craddock designed and established an infrastructure for supporting the commissaries in Europe; and he improved fill rates 80 percent. He also oversaw the complex phase in of the new Meals, Ready-to-Eat. He was instrumental in developing a program to improve inventory accuracy. And he flawlessly supervised operation of the Defense Subsistence Offices.
