UNITED STATES MARINE CORPS**

Is inducted into the Defense Industrial Supply Center Hall of Fame this twentieth day of January 1999 for his extraordinary leadership and support as an Inventory Management Division Chief in the Directorate of Supply Operations and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DISC from 1984 to 1987.

Lieutenant Colonel Lee was responsible for the item management of approximately 200,000 items. Recognizing the critical nature and impact of these items on the readiness of weapons systems, he realized an improvement in the customer forecast and interface area was needed. He initiated the Critical Item Review Program, which to this day, is indicative of DISC's customer responsiveness and support.
