Is posthumously inducted into the Defense Personnel Support Center Hall of Fame this eleventh day of July 1996 for his extraordinary leadership and support as Chief of the Clothing & Textiles Branch of the Clothing & Textiles Directorate – and for his continuous outstanding mission support throughout his tenure at DPSC – from 1963 to 1994. Mr. Husser spearheaded a number of innovative buying initiatives. He led the first implementation of DPSC's Best Value Buying Practices which was used as a model throughout the Defense Logistics Agency.
