3) Page 9, I. Introduction, A:

DLA Troop Support Europe and Africa intends to enter into Indefinite Quantity Contract (IQC) contracts with commercial firms to supply a full line of the European equivalents to USDA No.1 or better Fresh Fruit and Vegetable (FF&V) products to Department of Defense (DoD) Customers located in Southern Europe. <u>Payments to awardee are to be made in currency of awardee's country of origin</u>. <u>All offers are to be made in US Dollars</u>.

4) Page 11, IV. New Items, B.

The Government reserves the right to add Fresh Fruit and Vegetable (FF&V) items to the catalog after award. After ordering commencement, if a customer desires to order a Fresh Fruit and Vegetable (FF&V) item that is not part of the ordering catalog, the Contractor will be allowed a maximum of twenty (20) days to source the item, submit a new stock number request from DLA Troop Support Europe and Africa (if required) and add the item to the ordering catalog via an 832 Catalog transaction. These items should then become a permanent part of the Contractor's inventory, dependent upon availability, after the Contracting Officer's determination of fair and reasonable pricing. The contractor shall utilize the Contracting Officer provided form when requesting all item approvals (additions and/or changes). The form is mandatory and is Attachment 2. Addition of a new item(s) may not exceed the contract maximum dollar value stated.

5) Page 23, XXIII. Food Defense, A:

The DLA Troop Support Europe and Africa Subsistence Directorate provides world-wide subsistence logistics support during peace time as well as during regional conflicts, contingency operations, national emergencies, and natural disasters. At any time, the United States Government, its personnel, resources and interests may be the target of enemy aggression to include espionage, sabotage, or terrorism. This increased risk requires DLA Troop Support to take steps to ensure measures are taken to prevent the deliberate tampering and contamination of subsistence items.
