It is the intent of the Government to make two awards, one award for Zone 1 and one award for Zone 2. Each zone will be independently evaluated for best value. Additionally, zones will be awarded in the order of size (dollar value). The apparent successful offeror will be determined for the largest zone first then the smaller zone second, i.e. Zone 2, and then Zone 1.
