1. The Offer Due Date as listed on Solicitation Page 1, Block 8 is changed to December 14, 2010, 2:00 PM Philadelphia Time.

2. This acquisition has been changed to include a single, 1 Year Option period in addition to the original base period. Regarding this change, the following changes/revisions to the solicitation are made:

a. Solicitation Page 40, SOW I. Supplies/Services and Prices, paragraph 1D, the final sentence is changed to read, "This contract will be for a one (1) year base delivering term with one (1) year option period."

b. Solicitation Page 40, SOW I. Supplies/Services and Prices, paragraph 1E, the table is amended as listed below:

c. Solicitation Page 41, SOW I. Supplies/Services and Prices, paragraph 3, Options is changed to read "This contract includes one 1-Year Option Period. Acceptance of this option by the successful Prime Vendor is mandatory."

d. FAR Clause 52.217-9 - Option to Extend the Term of the Contract – is incorporated in full text:

FAR 52.217-9 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT (Mar 2000)

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 3 days provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed 2 years and 2 months. **(NOTE: The performance period is defined as the 12 month base period followed by the one 1 year option period. There will be a 2 month (60 day) implementation period upon award.)**

e. FAR Clause 52.222-43, Fair Labor Standards Act and Service Contract Act – Price Adjustment (Multiple Year and Option Contracts) (SEP 2009) 29 U.S.C. 206 and 41 U.S.C. 351, et seq.) found on page 22 of the solicitation is now incorporated into this acquisition.

f. Solicitation Page 49, SOW I. Supplies/Services and Prices, paragraph 8.B.4 Distribution Price - the final sentence is changed to read, "The Distribution Price shall remain fixed throughout each base and option period of the contract."

g. Solicitation Page 70, SOW III. Inspection and Acceptance, paragraph 11.B.1.c, the first sentence is changed to read "Each Prime Vendor will undergo an initial audit once per contract period with the first audit occurring during the base period and other initial audits occurring once per option period." Also, the final sentence of the same paragraph is changed to read, " **NOTE:** The Government reserves the right to conduct an Unannounced QSMV in lieu of an initial audit or other audit during the base period and/or any option period if deemed in the best interest of the Government."

h. Solicitation Page 95, SOW VI. Special Contract Requirements, Paragraph 1.A. Non-Compete Provision is removed in its entirety and replaced with the following:
"The offeror warrants that it will not actively promote, encourage, or market any of the customers on this acquisition away from a resultant DLA TROOP SUPPORT contract and onto a contract of any other Government agency or commercial entity. This prohibition applies both on a pre-award and post-award basis. The Contracting Officer reserves the right to resolicit the contract and may not exercise the option to extend the term of the contract if he/she discovers that the successful Prime Vendor has violated this provision. Customers that have been approached by a vendor regarding ordering off of a separate contract should immediately contact the Contracting Officer."

i. Solicitation Page 126, Addendum to FAR 52.212-1, Paragraph 4, the following statement is added:
"Any award made against this solicitation will result in an indefinite quantity contract of a base period of twelve (12) months and will include one(1) available option periods. The available Option period will be twelve (12) months. The Government also reserves the right to rescind the solicitation and not to make any award."
