f. Solicitation Page 49, SOW I. Supplies/Services and Prices, paragraph 8.B.4 Distribution Price - the final sentence is changed to read, "The Distribution Price shall remain fixed throughout each base and option period of the contract."

g. Solicitation Page 70, SOW III. Inspection and Acceptance, paragraph 11.B.1.c, the first sentence is changed to read "Each Prime Vendor will undergo an initial audit once per contract period with the first audit occurring during the base period and other initial audits occurring once per option period." Also, the final sentence of the same paragraph is changed to read, "**NOTE:** The Government reserves the right to conduct an Unannounced QSMV in lieu of an initial audit or other audit during the base period and/or any option period if deemed in the best interest of the Government."

h. Solicitation Page 95, SOW VI. Special Contract Requirements, Paragraph 1.A. i. The available Option period will be twelve (12) months. The Government also reserves the right to rescind the solicitation and not to make any award."
