## Amendment 0028

- 1. Amendment 0021 Page 119, Solicitation Provisions, Addendum to FAR 52.212-1 the following paragraph is added:
- 7. Add: Paragraph (n), Reverse Auction Instructions:

For solicitation SPM300-10-R-0047, the Government will use on-line reverse auctioning during price discussions. The reverse auction establishes the final offered prices from each offeror. DLAD Provision 52.215-9023(a) states "the reverse on-line auction will be used as a pricing technique during discussions to establish the final offered prices from each offeror." For the purposes of this acquisition, "final offered prices" shall mean the sum of the Aggregate Unit Prices. The award decision will be made in accordance with the evaluation factors as set forth in Amendment 0021, page 134 and Amendment 0026, page 29 (see below):

"Aggregate Unit Price is obtained by adding the Aggregate Distribution Price and the Aggregate Delivered Price for the base period and option period. This Aggregate Unit Price will be used to determine the lowest overall price to the Government.

## **NOTES:**

- 1. The Estimated Aggregate Distribution Price with Fuel Surcharge (DPFS) will be added to the Aggregate Delivered Price to arrive at the Estimated Aggregate Unit Price with Fuel Surcharge.
  - Estimated Aggregate Distribution Price with Fuel Surcharge + Aggregate Delivered Price = Estimated Aggregate Unit Price with Fuel Surcharge
- 2. Since the additional estimated expenditures will increase the estimated Aggregate Unit Price for DPFS offers, award using fuel surcharge will be deemed beneficial only if the Estimated Aggregate Unit Price with Fuel Surcharge is sufficiently lower than the Estimated Aggregate Unit Price (without Fuel Surcharge) to more than offset both this increased expenditure and the additional risk that is shifted to the Government by awarding with a fuel surcharge. The Government reserves the right to determine whether any such offset is sufficient to justify awarding with a fuel surcharge."

For this acquisition, the on-line reverse auction procedure will only be used to negotiation Distribution Prices (with and without fuel surcharge). As a result, and in order to establish the final offered prices through the on-line reverse auction, the offerors will only be able to decrease their proposed Distribution Prices (with and without Fuel Surcharge) for the base and option period through the reverse auction. All offerors will be required to submit final proposal

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revisions for their Delivered Prices and Non-Price Proposals outside of the reverse auction procedure and prior to the start of on-line reverse auction.

The on-line reverse auction will allow the offerors to decrease their Distribution Prices for the base and option period, with and without Fuel Surcharge. Thus, for each of the thirty-eight (38) Distribution Price Categories there will be four (4) auctioned prices for a total of one hundred fifty-two (152) Distribution Category Prices. The Government will not show quantities or aggregate pricing in the reverse auction. Offerors will be allowed to decrease their Distribution Prices in bid decrements of at least \$0.01 for each Distribution Price Category. Each offeror should try to provide its best price for each Distribution Price Category even if it cannot surpass the low offer in that category (the Government will allow for ties) since every price reduction in the auction will lower an offeror's final offered price. Therefore, it is recommended that the offerors keep track of changes to their Aggregate Unit Price based upon the changes to the individual distribution prices.

The lowest offeror's price for each individual Distribution Price Category will be disclosed to other offerors. This disclosure will be anonymous, meaning that each offeror's identity will be concealed from other offerors. An offeror's final auction price for each of the one hundred fifty-two (152) auctioned prices at the close of the reverse auction will be considered its final proposal revision.

The auction is tentatively scheduled to take place on 08 November 2012 with training on 07 November 2012. The auction shall run for 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM Local Philadelphia Time without any extensions and all one hundred fifty-two (152) auctioned prices will be opened and closed simultaneously.
