The purpose of this amendment to Solicitation SPE300-23-R-0028 is to:

1. Extend the due date until Wednesday, August 2, 2023.

2. The following language on page 15 of the solicitation should be removed:

A. The minimum order requirement for any resultant contract is \$25.00. This requirement shall be based on the aggregate total of orders for a specific delivery date to all customers located within a particular military base or delivery location.

Replace with:

a. The minimum order requirement for any resultant contract is \$75.00. This requirement shall be based on the aggregate total of orders for a specific delivery date to all customers located within a particular military base or delivery location.

3. The following language on page 44 of the solicitation should be removed:

(a) Minimum order. When the Government requires supplies or services covered by this contract in an amount of less than \$25.00, the Government is not obligated to purchase, nor is the Contractor obligated to furnish, those supplies or services under the contract.

Replace with:

(a) Minimum order. When the Government requires supplies or services covered by this contract in an amount of less than \$75.00, the Government is not obligated to purchase, nor is the Contractor obligated to furnish, those supplies or services under the contract.
