1. The closing date for this solicitation has been extended. On page 2, revise the “OFFER DUE DATE/LOCAL TIME” from October 2, 2008, 3:00 P.M. PHILADELPHIA TIME to December 02, 2008, 3:00 P.M. PHILADELPHIA TIME and add the following note:

**NOTE: New initial offers will be accepted. New offers shall be submitted in accordance with the methods and to the locations set forth on pages 2-6 and 142-170 of the solicitation.**

**Revised initial offers will be accepted from firms that submitted their offer no later than the initial closing date of October 2, 2008, 3:00 P.M. Philadelphia time. Revisions to initial offers are not required, but may be submitted in response to this amendment, if necessary. Revisions shall be submitted in accordance with the methods and to the locations set forth on pages 2-6 and 142-170 of the solicitation.**

**A re-submitted technical proposal shall only contain technical revisions. Do not re-submit any technical information that has already been provided. If a revision is made, clearly reference or link each revision to its associated technical factor, page number and paragraph as stated in the original technical proposal.**

**A re-submitted cost or price proposal shall only contain cost or price revisions. Do not re-submit quotes or invoices that have already been provided. However, if a product price is revised, the offeror must submit the associated quote or invoice. If any data is revised on attachments 1 thru 5, this data shall be clearly differentiated from the original data submitted.**

**If revisions are made to the solicitation document itself, re-submit the entire solicitation with highlighted revisions. If no changes are made, do not re-submit the solicitation.**

**Revised initial offers shall be separately bound by zone and clearly labeled as to vendor, zone, volume title, and copy number. Six copies are required for technical proposal revisions, two copies are required for cost or price proposal revisions and one copy is required for solicitation revisions.**

**All offerors are required to submit a signed copy of this amendment.**

2. On page 2, delete the following statement: Transmit facsimile revisions of offers to: 215-737-9300, 9301, 9302, or 9303.

3. On page 2, revise the “NOTE” at the bottom of the page to read as follows:

**NOTE: Facsimile and E-mail Offers are not acceptable forms of transmission for submission of initial proposals or revisions to initial proposals submitted in response to this amendment. As directed by the Contracting Officer, facsimile and e-mail may be used during discussions/negotiations, if discussions/negotiations are held, for proposal revision(s), including Final Proposal revision(s).**

4. On page 17, add the following clause after paragraph (d) of FAR 52.216-22:

**FAR 52.228-3 – Workers Compensation Insurance (Defense Base Act) (Apr 1984)**

The Contractor shall

(a) provide, before commencing performance under this contract, such workers' compensation insurance or security as the Defense Base Act (42 U.S.C. 1651, *et seq.*) requires and

(b) continue to maintain it until performance is completed. The Contractor shall insert, in all subcontracts under this contract to which the Defense Base Act applies, a clause similar to this clause (including this sentence) imposing upon those subcontractors this requirement to comply with the Defense Base Act.

5. On page 56, delete paragraph I, "Backhauling Government Furnished Material – Iraq only" in its entirety.
6. On page 72, paragraph 3, "Normal Distribution Price," delete "and Iraq backhauling" from the definition.
