1. The closing date for this solicitation has been extended. On page 2, revise the "OFFER DUE DATE/LOCAL TIME" from December 08, 2008, 3:00 P.M. PHILADELPHIA TIME to January 15, 2009, 3:00 P.M. PHILADELPHIA TIME and add the following note:

NOTE:

New initial offers will not be accepted.

Revised offers will be accepted only from firms that submitted their initial or initial revised offer no later than the previous closing date of December 08, 2008, 3:00 P.M. Philadelphia time.

Revisions shall be limited to the cost or price proposal distribution prices on attachment 1 for Zone I offers and attachment 2 for Zone II offers and only as those revisions are directly related to the allocation of costs related to the Defense Base Act (DBA) and the Longshore and Harbor Workers Compensation Act into the normal distribution price as clarified by this amendment. Other cost or price proposal revisions will not be accepted. Technical proposal revisions will not be accepted. Revisions to other supporting documents; i.e., solicitation, invoices, quotes, etc. will not be accepted.

Attachment 1 and/or 2 revisions are not required, but may be submitted in response to this amendment, if necessary. The formulas in attachments 3 through 5 will automatically update the distribution prices on attachments 3 through 5 based on any revisions that are made to attachments 1 and/or 2. Option pricing may also change as a result of any revisions that are made to attachments 1 and/or 2. Therefore, if revisions are made to attachments 1 and/or 2, two copies of the entire cost or price proposal must be submitted (on CD and a paper copy – two copies each) to show the overall effect to the cost or price proposal.

One signed copy of this amendment is required to be submitted whether or not the offeror elects to submit revised distribution pricing.

Facsimiles and E-mails are not acceptable forms of transmission for the submission of revised cost or price proposals or signed copies of this amendment. All revisions and the signed copy of this amendment are required to be mailed to the DSCP Post Office Box 56667 or hand carried to the DSCP Business Opportunities Office as described on pages 2-3 of the solicitation.

2. On page 6, add the following note to the bottom of the page:

NOTE: All cost associated with workers' compensation insurance as related to the Defense Base Act (DBA) and the Longshore and Harbor Workers Compensation Act shall be allocated within the normal distribution price.

3. On page 70, add the following note below the Zone 2 table in Paragraph B.
“ACQUISITION VALUE:”

NOTE: The above estimated dollar values are based on the best available information prior to the Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) effective January 01, 2009. The estimated dollar values will be verified by the government prior to award of any contract resulting from this solicitation. Upon verification, if there is a substantial change to any of the stated estimated dollar values, the solicitation will be amended. In such an event, offerors will be notified and provided an opportunity to make appropriate proposal revisions.

4. On page 72, number 3 “Normal Distribution Price” definition, revise the second sentence to read as follows: The normal distribution price includes the Prime Vendor’s projected general and administrative expenses, workers compensation insurance as related to the Defense Base Act (DBA) and the Longshore and Harbor Workers Compensation Act, overhead, profit, packaging/marketing/labeling costs, all Non Point of Manufacturer fees (CONUS and OCONUS Broker, Dealer, Subcontractor and Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Consolidation Point fees) including, but not limited to procurement, storage, consolidation, pallets, palletizing and distribution work.
