This Modification incorporates the two changes listed below. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

- The following language is added to page 123, section C. ORDER PLACEMENT LEAD TIMES:

Note: In addition to normal or routine deliveries, the Prime Vendor may be required to make deliveries 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

- The following section has been added to page 126.

H. Contingency Cold Chain Storage

At any time during the contract, the contractor may be notified that Government intends to invoke a contingency plan for the Government's own use of cold chain storage facilities within the GOCO. The Government will review capacity and open space within the warehouse before making a determination to invoke such a plan. The following procedures will be used.

A. Government Owned Contractor Operated (GOCO) Facility Procedure:

In certain circumstances, the Government may require the use of a limited portion of the GOCO facility for its own storage requirements. In this situation, the Government will be responsible for the storage of the product in the GOCO. All of the delivery, movement, maintenance, pick-up, etc., will be done completely by the customer or another Government entity. PUI will not be responsible for the Government owned product stored in the GOCO under the terms of this provision. PUI, its employees, representatives, agents, etc., shall not touch, handle, or otherwise interact with these Government stored items while the items are stored in the GOCO. PUI must also make reasonable efforts to ensure the Government stored items are not otherwise damaged as a result of PUI's performance under this contract. The Government's intent under this provision is to occupy a limited portion of the GOCO for the storage of Government material where it will be left until picked up. Because PUI will not be responsible for this material, invocation of this provision will come at no cost to the Government. This contingency cold chain storage will only be invoked under this contract WHILE PUI IS A TENNAT IN THE GOCO.

Because medical items may be stored in the GOCO under this provision, PHC may be required to approve the storage of these items in the GOCO. Although the Government will coordinate any required PHC approvals, PUI shall reasonably cooperate with any required inspection.
