# I. SOLICITATION/CONTRACT FORM

The terms and conditions set forth in solicitation SPE300-22-R-0029 are incorporated into subject contract.

The following documents and all terms and conditions contained therein are incorporated by reference into this contract: your final offer dated May 16, 2023.

# II. PERFORMANCE PERIOD:

#### A. Effective Period of the Contract:

Tier 1 - September 29, 2023 through September 27, 2025

Tier 2 - September 28, 2025 through September 25, 2027

Ordering will commence within the first 90 days after the contract is awarded, with first delivery scheduled beginning on December 8, 2023 for schools and reservations.

# B. ESTIMATED DOLLAR VALUE/GUARANTEED MINIMUM/MAXIMUM

Both Groups have been awarded together, and therefore, the total 10% Guaranteed Minimum contract dollar value is \$563,755.00 and the 300% Maximum contract dollar value is \$67,650,600.00. The guaranteed minimum and maximum, although based on estimates, are a firm dollar amount calculated as a percentage of the estimated dollar value. The guaranteed minimum constitutes the Government's legal ordering obligation under the contract.

The 24 Month (1st Tier) Estimate is \$11,275,100.00 and the 4 Year (All Tiers) Estimate is \$22,550,200.00. The term "4 Year Estimate" refers to the Government's good faith estimate of the requirement for all Tier periods.

### III. START-UP PERIOD

The Contractor's startup period will take place prior to the first order and is included in the 24-month Tier I period. The Contractor shall submit a proposed implementation schedule to the Contracting Officer within fifteen (15) days after award highlighting the steps that will be taken to implement a fully functional distribution account, including all EDI transactions for all customers covered by this solicitation. An additional sixty (60) days will be granted for actual implementation. No more than ninety (90) days after award will be permitted for the contractor to have fully functional distribution accounts in place for all customers.

length of the contract period. To further illustrate this point, Attachment 1 (Final Pricing) includes a separate column that identifies the percentage EPA ceiling for the individual Delivered Prices of each line item on the catalog. This price represents the maximum increase in Delivered Price allowable for the entire 4-year length of the Contract. For additional information, see the EPA provision as specified in the Solicitation.
