SUBJECT: AbilityOne Suppliers on Subsistence Prime Vendor Contracts

As the Commander of DLA Troop Support, I am calling upon you to support the AbilityOne Program not only because it is a requirement in your contract based on a Federal statute, but also because it has my personal commitment and frankly, it is the right thing to do.

Currently, there are various community-based, nonprofit agencies from SourceAmerica and National Industries for the Blind (NIB) identified in your contract as the mandatory source for several items. The orders you submit to AbilityOne generate many positives to a deserving segment of the population, including employment opportunities. Unfortunately, it appears that these mandatory sources are not receiving all the business that they should be receiving.
