

Subject: ALFOODACT 006-2011 Evergreen Fresh Sprouts, LLC Voluntarily Recalls Alfalfa Sprouts and Spicy Sprouts

Date Issued: July 7, 2011

1. REFERENCES:

2. BACKGROUND:

Evergreen Fresh Sprouts of Moyie Springs, Idaho is voluntarily recalling its conventional alfalfa sprout products as a precaution because it has the potential to be contaminated with Salmonella.

3. PRODUCTION DATES/IDENTIFYING CODES:

The recalled products are coded with Expiration Dates from 06 22 through 07 14. The products being recalled are identified as:

- Alfalfa Sprouts, Evergreen Produce, 4 oz. bag, UPC 8 38796 00103 7.
- Alfalfa Sprouts, Evergreen Produce, 16 oz. bag, UPC 8 38796 00108 2.
- Alfalfa Sprouts, Evergreen Produce, 5 lb. bag, no UPC.
- Spicy Sprouts, Evergreen Produce, 4 oz. bag, UPC 8 38796 00102 0.
- Spicy Sprouts, Evergreen Produce, 16 oz. or 5 lb. bag, no UPC.

4. MANUFACTURER/DISTRIBUTOR:

5. DISTRIBUTION: Manufacture is listed in the Worldwide Directory of Sanitarily Approved Food Establishments for Armed Forces Procurement. Plant was suspended from procurement on 27 June 2011.

6. REASON FOR ACTION: Potentially contaminated with Salmonella.

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

- a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use. POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency

representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, or Manufacturers).

b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. In order to get credit please use a SF 364 and forward to your supporting FISC and copy furnished to NAVSUP 51. Your supporting FISC should forward to the account manager at DLA Troop Support. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home ported ships/galleys will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DLA Troop Support.

c. DLA Troop Support Subsistence Prime Vendors must report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to the their DLA Troop Support Contracting Officer with a courtesy copy to the Consumer Safety Officer (dscpconssafofc@dla.mil).

d. DeCA, AAFES, MWR, VA, MCCS, or other non-DLA Troop Support agencies SHOULD NOT respond to the DLA Troop Support Consumer Safety Officer. These agencies should report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE responses in accordance with their agency recall policies.
