SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2016-021: Ouhlala Gourmet LLC recalls Fruit Tartlets for undeclared milk.

This is a Potential Class II recall due to milk contained in product that is not declared on label. Information on this recall was provide directly from Lisa Gilliam, FDA/OEIO Recalls CDR, USPHS

2. BACKGROUND:

Ouhlala Gourmet LLC dba Buddy Fruits is voluntarily recalling their Tartlets products due to the lack of milk allergen communication on packages. The current Tartlets ingredients list states "butter," a milk-derived ingredient; however, the FDA notified Buddy Fruits that additional milk allergen clarification must be included. Product first went to distribution centers and then to individual retail stores. According to Ouhlala Gourmet LLC, Military Centers affected are as follow:

7. INSTRUCTIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MESSAGE RECIPIENTS:

a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use.

POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek/refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, or Manufacturers).

b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion. Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved.
