SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2016-048: **Kill Cliff KC (Kill Cliff) recalls Strawberries & Cream Protien Bars due to mold contamination.**

Products may be contaminated with mold.

Date Issued: July 8, 2016

1. REFERENCES:

2. BACKGROUND:

Kill Cliff received a customer complaint of mold being found on a purchased bar. Kill Cliff reviewed their internal samples and found mold on some of the examples examined. Kill Cliff ceased fulfilling any open orders for this product, providing refunds and exchanges. The bars in question were sent to an independent lab for testing. The mold was found to be a common, non-toxic variety that is common on fruits. The test results showed mold present on 15% of the bars. The decision was made to recall the bars in order to maintain our standard of quality.

a. Immediately inventory stocks to identify the above items and secure in a "Medical Hold" status to provide assurance of no further issue/sale/use.

POSITIVE FINDINGS should be reported to Accountable Officers/Vendor Representatives of that facility. Accountable Officer/Agency representatives/Buyers/Contracting Officers should seek/refund/credit/replacement through the normal distribution channel with which the product was received (i.e. Distribution Centers, Prime Vendors, or Manufacturers).

b. Ships at sea are authorized to destroy or dispose of recalled products at their discretion.

Documentation for the number of pounds and cases, and any additional pertinent information must be signed by the Accountable Officer and is required for the purpose of recouping to the government the cost of the product involved. Your supporting NAVSUP FLC should forward to the account manager at DLA Troop Support. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home-ported ships/galleys will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer w/ reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DLA Troop Support.

c. DLA Troop Support Subsistence Prime Vendors must report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE RESPONSES directly to their DLA Troop Support Contracting Officer with a courtesy copy to the Consumer Safety Officer (dscpconssafofc@dlamail).

d. DeCA, AAFES, MWR, VA, MCCS, or other non-DLA Troop Support agencies SHOULD NOT respond to the DLA Troop Support Consumer Safety Officer. These agencies should report POSITIVE and NEGATIVE responses in accordance with their agency recall policies.
