BACKGROUND: Ferrara Candy Company has initiated a voluntary recall of Brach's® 5 ounce Almond Supremes with a best by date of 4/22/2017 after discovering that some Brach's® Almond Supremes packages may include Brach's® Bridge Mix, a product that contains peanuts and wheat. The affected product was distributed throughout retail stores in Florida, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Ohio, South Carolina, Texas, Washington and Wisconsin.
