SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2018-002 – Flowers Foods Recalls Frozen Dough - Listeria

Date Issued: 5 January 2018

1. REFERENCES:

a. DLAR 4155.26/AR 40-660/NAVSUPINST 10110.8c/AFI 48-116/MCO 10110.38c, DOD Hazardous Food & Nonprescription Drug Recall System.

2. Background: Routine regulatory laboratory testing was conducted at the Flowers Foods Bakery, samples revealed the presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*. Several brand names have been affected by this recall, see product affected section below.

This recall has been initiated as a precautionary measure due to possible contamination with *Listeria monocytogenes*. Although this product is not ready-to-eat and has baking instructions that reduce consumer risk, if followed, there is a possibility that mishandling this product prior to or without adequate baking may cause illness. Eating food contaminated with the *Listeria monocytogenes* can cause sickness and adverse health consequences in pregnant women and their newborns, adults aged 65 or older, and people with weakened immune systems.

No illnesses have been reported in connection with this recalled product.





