SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2018-007 – H.I.G. Corporation AFC Frozen Tuna - Listeria

1. REFERENCES:

a. DLAR 4155.26/AR 40-660/NAVSUPINST 10110.8c/AFI 48-116/MCO 10110.38c, DOD Hazardous Food & Nonprescription Drug Recall System.

2. Background: During routine testing, one lot of Advanced Fresh Concepts (AFC) Frozen Tuna Fillet Saku was positive for *Listeria*.

3. Affected Product: CV Giovanni Sukses Makmur in Indonesia processes the tuna for the H.I.G. Corporation in Carson, CA. One lot of AFC frozen tuna fillet saku, Lot # 117055 was sold in Commissary sushi bars. The following is a list of potential delivery locations, however, all facilities should verify that this product isn't in their stores.

manager at DLA Troop Support. The form should include the number of the recall authorizing the survey action. Home-ported ships/galleys will utilize DD form 1149 to transfer with reimbursement to the PV. The PV will submit credit invoice to the account manager at DLA Troop Support.

d. **AAFES, MWR, NEX, MCCS, DeCA, DLA, dining facilities**, and **all other agencies**, report your findings in accordance with the procedures outlined by your agency.
