SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2018-014 – Heartland Coca-Cola Beverages – Sharp edges

Date Issued: 26 February 2018

1. REFERENCES:

a. DLAR 4155.26/AR 40-660/NAVSUPINST 10110.8c/AFI 48-116/MCO 10110.38c, DOD Hazardous Food & Nonprescription Drug Recall System.

2. Background: Sharp edges were observed on several of the cans which have the potential of causing cuts on the mouths of consumers who use the product.

3. Product affected: The voluntary recall is limited to **only the specific production codes** listed below.
