SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2018-025 – Hungry Jack Original Pancake & Waffle Mix – Salmonella

Date Issued: 9 April 2018

1. REFERENCES:

2. Background: Please be advised The J.M. Smucker Company initiated a limited, voluntary retail-level recall on three specific lot codes of its Hungry Jack Original Pancake & Waffle Mix because it may be contaminated with Salmonella.

Salmonella, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Healthy persons infected with Salmonella often experience fever, diarrhea (which may be bloody), nausea, vomiting and abdominal pain. In rare circumstances, infection with Salmonella can result in the organism getting into the bloodstream and producing more severe illnesses such as arterial infections (i.e., infected aneurysms), endocarditis and arthritis.

Roughly 9,500 cases of impacted Hungry Jack Original Pancake & Waffle Mix product were distributed through a limited number of retailers and distributors nationwide. Only Best If Used By Dates 5/27/2019, 5/28/2019, and 5/29/2019 are impacted.

There have been no reports of any illnesses associated with this recall. Product is being recalled out of an abundance of caution.

If this product has been further distributed beyond your facilities, please contact your accounts and advise them of the limited, voluntary class II recall.

This voluntary class II recall is being made with the full knowledge of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration
