2. Background: The Coca-Cola Company is voluntarily recalling a limited quantity of Odwalla Superfood packaged in single-serve 15.2-oz. bottles. This product does not meet our high-quality standards due to the potential presence of foreign matter in a specific ingredient used in this product. We are taking this voluntary action because nothing is more important than the safety of the people who drink our beverages.

The product being recalled carries the Lot Codes listed below.

This product was distributed to multiple distribution centers in the United States. No other beverages, package types or date codes are involved. Only the items referenced below are impacted by this action.
