- 2. Background: Utz Quality Foods, LLC, is voluntarily recalling select expiration dates of Utz<sup>®</sup> Carolina Style Barbeque Potato Chips due to undeclared soy allergen. As part of a process to reformulate and remove soy from the seasoning formula of these items, new packaging was created to reflect the change. However, the new packaging was introduced before the reformulated seasoning was available for product manufacturing. This event was isolated and extraordinary, and is not our standard manufacturing practice.

Consumers should NOT eat this product subject to the voluntary recall. Consumers who purchased the product are encouraged to return it to the store where it was purchased for a full refund or exchange, or they may simply discard it.

There have been no reported illnesses associated with this voluntary recall.
