SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2019-053 – Jumbo Foods Inc. Expands Recall of Tuscan Sun Brand Chicken Salad Sandwiches for Possible *Listeria monocytogenes* Contamination

Date Issued: 10 October 2019

1. REFERENCES:

2. BACKGROUND: Jumbo Foods Inc. of Mukilteo, WA issued a voluntary recall of Tuscan Sun (TS) brand chicken salad sandwiches, because it has the potential to be contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, listeria infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

Jumbo Foods Inc. began shipping these frozen and/or refrigerated sandwich products between March 11, 2019 and September 27, 2019. Frozen sandwiches have no sell-by or use-by date printed on the packages and have an 8-months shelf life. Frozen products will be thawed, and the expiry dates are applied at stores. Refrigerated sandwiches distributed by Jumbo Foods have 28 days shelf life and the sell by or use by date stickers are observed on packages.

The following affected sandwich products were distributed exclusively by Jumbo Foods Inc. to food service and retail stores in Arizona, California, Nevada, North Carolina, Oregon, Utah, Virginia, and Washington.

This recall was brought to Jumbo Foods attention by The Suter Company whose poultry supplier, Tip Top Poultry Inc., issued a voluntary recall of ready-to-eat (RTE) poultry products due to possible *Listeria* contamination. This recall is being made with the knowledge of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration.

Consumers who have purchased these recalled products should not consume them. Consumers should discard the products or return them to the point of purchase.

No illnesses have been reported to date in relation to these products or recall.
