SUBJECT: ALFOODACT 2020-016 – Beyond Better Foods, LLC Issues Allergy Alert on Undeclared Milk in Mislabeled Chocolate Peanut Butter Pint Ice Cream

Date Issued: 25 June 2020

1. REFERENCES:

BACKGROUND: Beyond Better Foods, LLC, is recalling select pints from a single production run of Enlightened brand Chocolate Peanut Butter ice cream pints because they may have been packaged in Dairy-Free Chocolate Peanut Butter containers and thus contain undeclared milk ingredients. People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to milk run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume these products.

The affected product was distributed nationwide in grocery stores. Beyond Better Foods is taking immediate steps to recall all affected products.

This recall is the result of mislabeled product. Chocolate Peanut Butter product was packaged in non-dairy chocolate peanut butter packaging. The Chocolate Peanut Butter produced for Enlightened by Cedar Crest Ice Cream contains dairy. Specifically, one lot of Chocolate Peanut Butter ice cream was mistakenly filled in pint-sized Enlightened brand Dairy-Free Chocolate Peanut Butter pint containers. These packages have a base container labeled “Dairy-Free Chocolate Peanut Butter” and a lid labeled “Chocolate Peanut Butter” without a “Dairy-Free” callout. All affected products have a “best by” date of November 5, 2021 which is printed on the bottom of the container.
