SUBJECT: Church & Dwight Co., Inc. Initiates Voluntary Recall of Select Vitamin Products Due to the Potential Presence of a Foreign Material

1. **REFERENCE.** DHA-MSR 6025.01/AR 40-660/ DLAR 6025.01/NAVSUPINST 10110.8D/AFI 48-161_IP/MCO 10110.38D, DOD Hazardous Food & Nonprescription Drug Recall System, 6 September 2018.

2. **BACKGROUND.** Church & Dwight Co., Inc. is initiating a voluntary recall of select vitafusion vitamin products due to the potential presence of a foreign material, specifically a metallic mesh material. The recall involves product lots manufactured in a four-day period between October 29 and November 3, 2020 at one of the company’s manufacturing facilities.

Church & Dwight Co., Inc. is not aware of any reports of consumer illness or injury at the time of this publication. This recall is being coordinated with the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA).

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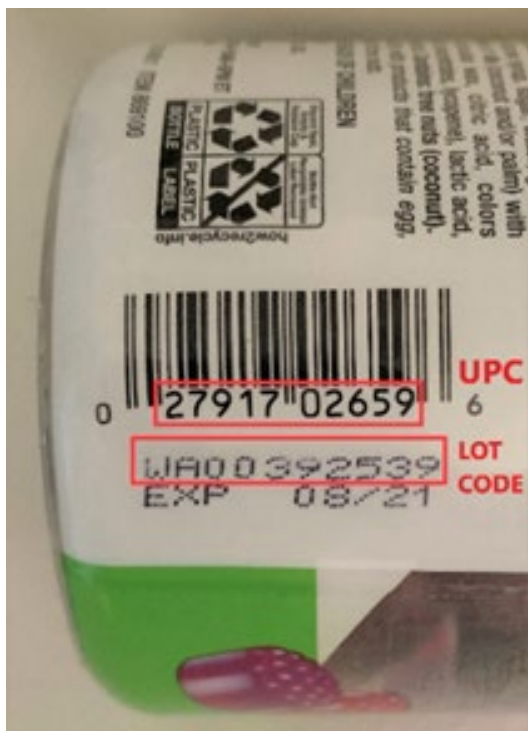
