Uniform Procurement Instrument Identification Changes Effective October 1, 2017

In order to standardize procurement transactions across the Federal Government, the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 4.16, Unique Procurement Instrument Identifiers (PIID) has been amended to implement a uniform award identification system referred to as the Procurement Instrument Identification (PIID).

For DLA, the new PIID structure will continue to require use of Activity Address Codes (AACs) as the unique identifier for contracting offices, the current fiscal year, instrument type and a four-character serial number. Existing contract, purchase order, and delivery order numbers will not change.

Beginning October 1, 2017:

<u>Task/Delivery Order Numbering Change:</u> Task/Delivery Order numbers will be issued with a unique 13character DO PIID comprised of a 6 position Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC), 2 position fiscal year, 9<sup>th</sup> position identifier of either "F" or "M" (FedMall award) and a 4-character serial number. The current four-character supplementary call number identifier will no longer be utilized.

Current: SPM4AR07D0100 (Basic Contract) 0050 (supplementary call number) Future: SPM4AR07D0100 (Basic Contract) SPE4A618F0022 (New Format DO PIID)

To maintain visibility of the sequence, a 6-position numeric Delivery Order Counter will be provided on both the Form DD 1155 Order for Supplies or Services and the Electronic Data Interchange 850 Award to Vendors. This counter will begin at 000001 on 1 October 2017 and will be maintained for each basic long term contract.

<u>Modification Length Change</u>: Modification numbers assigned to the new DO PIID will increase from 2 positions to 6 positions with implementation of this change.
