GENERAL ORDERS

NO. 20-75

I. Effective 1 Jun 75, the Defense Fuel Region (DFR), Alaska is established as a DSA Secondary Level Field Activity of the Defense Fuel Supply Center (DFSC) and collocated with Alaskan Air Command (AAC)/Alaskan North American Air Defense (NORAD) Logistics Staff at Anchorage, Alaska.

II. The Commander, DFR Alaska is responsible, in his assigned geographical area, for:

A. Provision of supply and transportation support to the Military Services and other authorized customers relating to bulk petroleum and services on DFSC contracts.

B. Contract Administration as defined in paragraph 1-406, Armed Services Procurement Regulation, of DFSC contracts for the supply of petroleum products and services to the Military Services and other authorized customers.

C. Representing the Commander, DFSC with the Commander AAC/Alaskan NORAD Region on assigned responsibilities relating to the integrated management of petroleum products and services in accordance with DFSC guidance implementing the provisions of DSAR 5805.15.

D. Maintaining liaison with the Military Services, other authorized customers and industry on assigned responsibilities relating to the integrated management of bulk petroleum products in accordance with DFSC guidance.

E. Exercise of command and control over all assigned subordinate DFSC field elements.

The office symbol for DFR, Alaska is DFSC-RK.

III. Interservice support agreements between DFSC and the AAC/Alaskan NORAD Region will provide for administrative support of DFR, Alaska.
