II. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 11 July 1983, Subject: Reorganization of the Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems.

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 31 July 1983, the Office of Telecommunications and Information Systems (DLA-Z) is realigned as follows:

A. The Programs and Analysis Office is redesignated as the Plans and Policy Office (DLA-ZP). The Chief, DLA-ZP will continue to be responsible for development and implementation of common policies, procedures, plans and programs for the DLA Telecommunications and Information Systems Program.

B. The AIS Development and Control Division (DLA-ZS) is established with four subordinate branches - AIS Architecture Control Branch, DoD Systems Branch, DCASR and Management Information Systems Branch and Materiel Management and Distribution Systems Branch. The Chief, DLA-ZS is responsible for administering the development, implementation, operation and maintenance of Automated Information Systems (AISs) in support of DLA and assigned DoD missions.

C. The Defense Automatic Addressing System Office (DAASO) is disestablished as a HQ DLA Management Support Activity (MSA) of the Information Systems Division, DLA-Z and reassigned as HQ DLA MSA of DLA-ZS.

D. The Technology Division (DLA-ZW) is established with four subordinate branches - ADP/T Acquisition Management Branch, Technical Support Branch, Advanced Research and Technology Branch and ADPER Program Management Branch. The Chief, DLA-ZW is responsible for DLA ADP and Telecommunications (ADP/T) technology assessments, research and development, and acquisition of ADP/T hardware, software and services.

E. The DLA Systems Engineering Office (DSEO) is established as a HQ DLA MSA located in Columbus, OH. Under the management, direction and control of the Chief, DLA-ZW, DSEO is responsible for systems engineering, systems architecture, acquisition and implementation of the DLA ADP Resource Acquisition Program and others as assigned.

F. The DLA ADP/Telecommunications Contracting Office (DACO) is established as a HQ DLA MSA located at Cameron Station, Alexandria, VA. Under the management, direction and control of the Assistant Director, DLA-Z, DACO is responsible for ADP/T contracting within DLA.


G. The DLA Regional Telecommunications Offices (RTOs) located in Richmond, VA; Columbus, OH, and Alameda, CA, are disestablished as HQ DLA MSAs of the Telecommunications Division, DLA-Z and their missions, functions and associated resources are reassigned to the Commander, DLA Systems Automation Center. The RTOs will continue to provide telecommunications support and assistance to DLA field activities within their respective regions.

H. The Acquisition and Technical Support Office, Office Automation Division, Information Systems Division, Telecommunications Division and the DLA ADPE Replacement Program Office are disestablished as organizational elements of DLA-Z and missions, functions and associated resources are reassigned to the newly established elements in paragraphs IIIB, D, E, and F above.

I. DLA General Orders No. 2-81, 4 Mar 81 and 3-81, 9 Mar 81 are rescinded.

IV. Administrative support for DLA-Z elements located at Cameron Station, Alexandria, VA, will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center. Administrative support for DSEO will be provided by the Defense Construction Supply Center.
