GENERAL ORDER

I. Authority: DLA-D Memorandum, 30 June 1983, Subject: DLA Study of Competitive Procurement Data Needs, approved by the DEPSECDEF.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 30 June 1983 the DLA Competitive Procurement Data Needs Study Group (DDNSG) is established as a DLA Management Support Activity (MSA) for a period not to exceed one (1) year.

III. Under the direction of the Director, Defense Logistics Agency, the DDNSG is responsible for:


A. Study policies, procedures and processes associated with data acquisition, transfer, maintenance and management within DLA and DoD components in support of the contracting function in furtherance of DoD/DLA competitive procurement needs and goals.

B. Document DLA's competitive procurement data needs and evaluate adequacy and currency of technical data within DLA.

C. Report findings, conclusions and recommendations both incrementally and upon completion of study effort.

IV. PSEs and PLFAs will provide supporting technical work effort, as required by the DDNSG. Administrative support for DDNSG will be furnished by the Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center.
