

I. Authority: DLA-LP Staff Summary Sheet, dated 28 July 1983 subject: Bulk Petroleum Implementation Plan.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 6 November 1983, responsibility for Petroleum Quality Surveillance is transferred from Defense Contract Administration Services Regions Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Cleveland, Dallas, Los Angeles, New York, Philadelphia and St. Louis to the Defense Fuel Supply Center.

III. The Commander, Defense Fuel Supply Center is responsible to the Director, Defense Logistics Agency for the aggregate of Quality Surveillance measures used to determine and maintain the quantity and quality of Government-owned bulk petroleum and petroleum products under the control of DLA and to ensure that they are transported and maintained until they have been accepted by a facility controlled by a Service or another Government agency.
