I. Authority: DLA-D approval on 24 August 1983, DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 17 August 1983, Subject: Safety and Health DLA-Wide.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 24 August 1983, the Headquarters Defense Logistics Agency Safety and Health Council, which will meet at the call of the Council Chairman, is established under the Director, DLA, for the purpose of formulating and recommending policies to reduce mishaps and providing a medium for exchanging ideas regarding DLA-wide policies and objectives towards safety and health programs, and medical activities. The Council is required to meet at least three times a year.

III. The Council membership will consist of as a minimum:

- A. The Deputy Director, DLA (DLA-DD) will serve as Council Chairman.
- B. The Staff Director, Installation Services and Environmental Protection, DLA (DLA-W) will serve as Executive Secretary.
- C. The following personnel will serve as Council Members:
  - 1. The Assistant Director, Plans, Policies and Programs, DLA (DLA-L).
  - 2. The Assistant Director, Telecommunications and Information Systems, DLA (DLA-Z).
  - 3. The Comptroller, DLA (DLA-C).
  - 4. The Executive Directors of Contract Management (DLA-A), Supply Operations (DLA-O), Contracting (DLA-P), Quality Assurance (DLA-Q) and Technical and Logistics Services (DLA-S).
  - 5. The DLA Command Security Officer (DLA-T).
  - 6. The Staff Director, Personnel, DLA (DLA-K).
  - 7. The DLA General Counsel, DLA (DLA-G).
  - 8. Four PLFA Commanders - one from a Supply Center, Depot, Service Center and DCASR to attend on a rotating basis.
- D. Other members appointed by the Council Chairman.

IV. Administrative support will be provided by DLA-W.
