

- I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 20 June 1984, subject: HQ DLA Realignment of DLA-U.
- II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 1 July 1984,
A. Program Administration for NIB/NISH is realigned from DLA-P to DLA-U.
B. The DLA Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization Support Office (SADBU) is established as a Management Support Activity (MSA) under the direction of DLA-U.
- III. The Staff Director, Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization, DLA is responsible for:
A. Administering DLA programs and policy for selected business firms including those categorized as small; disadvantaged; women owned; American Indian owned; labor surplus area located, and sheltered workshops affiliated with the National Industries for the Blind, and National Industries for the Severely Handicapped (SADBU firms).
B. Providing technical and administrative direction and control over all Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization Specialists within DLA and its subordinate activities.
- IV. The SADBU (MSA) is responsible for formulating and providing policy, procedures and program analysis, and executing DLA programs for SADBU firms.
- V. Administrative support for DLA-P and DLA-U will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC). Administrative support for the SADBU (MSA) will be provided by DASC.
