I. Authority: Organization & Mission Control Branch Staff Summary Sheet dated 6 August 1984, subject: Realignment of the Command Group, approved by the Director, Defense Logistics Agency.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 15 August 1984, the Agency Command Group is realigned:

A. The Deputy Director (DLA-DD) is responsible for assisting and advising the Director, DLA in the direction, control and management of the Agency mission.

B. The Deputy Director (Acquisition Management) (DLA-DD (AM)) is responsible for assisting and advising the Director, DLA in the direction, control and management of the Agency procurement, contracting, acquisition management and related missions as assigned.

C. The Chief of Staff (DLA-DC) is established and is responsible for coordinating, advising and assisting the Director and Deputy Directors, DLA, and managing the operational aspects of the Agency Headquarters.

D. The Executive, DLA is redesignated the Executive/Secretariat (DLA-DE) and is responsible for assisting the Chief of Staff in the coordination, integration and operation of the Agency Headquarters. Provides administrative control and support of the Agency Command Group.

E. Succession to the Director, DLA in order of availability is:

1. Deputy Director;
2. Deputy Director (Acquisition Management);
3. General/Flag Officer, in order of military rank seniority, among the Heads of HQ DLA Principal Staff Elements.

III. Administrative support for the Command Group will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center.
