I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 12 Dec 85, subject: Establishment of Installation Assistance Office - West.

II. This General Order adds a fifth branch to the Defense Installation Management Center (DIMC) which was restructured in General Order 15-85 dated 24 Apr 85.

III. Installation Assistance Office - West:

A. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 12 Jan 86, the Installation Assistance Office - West is established.

B. Under the direction of DIMC, the Installation Assistance Office - West is responsible for:

1. Promoting economy and efficiency in base operating support in the Western CONUS through the development, evaluation and recommendation of areas of study having potential for mutual support.

2. Assisting local study groups in the geographical area of responsibility with studies being considered or undertaken. Providing recommended actions on completed studies for Service/Agency evaluation.

3. Leading selected regional studies extending beyond a Joint Interservice Resource Study Group (JIRSG) area or affecting more than one JIRSG.

C. Program accountability for the Installation Assistance Office - West is assigned to the Assistant Secretary of Defense (Acquisition and Logistics) (Installations) ((ASD(A&L)(I)) and performance accountability is assigned to ASD(A&L)(I)(DIMC).

D. The branch will be located at Mather Air Force Base, California. Administrative and logistical support to the Installation Assistance Office - West will be provided by Defense Depot Tracy, and by Mather Air Force Base through an Interservice Support Agreement with Defense Depot Tracy.
