I. Authority. DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO staff summary sheet dated 21 October 1987, subject: Defense Productivity Program Office (DPPO) Restructuring.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 13 December 1987, DPPO, an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to the Director, Productivity and Civilian Requirements (ASD(FM&P)(RMS)(P&CR)), is restructured into two divisions: the Productivity Improvement Division and the Productivity Management Division. The DPPO mission is to administer the DoD productivity process for the enhancement, measurement and evaluation of the productivity and quality of Defense activities.


III. The divisions are responsible as follows:

a. The Productivity Improvement Division develops policy for productivity and quality improvement techniques.

b. The Productivity Management Division develops policy for the DoD productivity plan and productivity measurement and accomplishment reporting.

IV. Administrative support for DPPO will continue to be provided by the DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
